All grade 10 students will be writing the GNA 10 on EITHER

November 1 (Wednesday) OR November 2 (Thursday) from 8:30am –

11:30am. There will be an alternate schedule on these days and students shouldn't miss any regularly scheduled classes. PLT has been extended on these days.

Students can determine their assessment date/time/location by finding their name on the alphabetized lists posted on the office window. Students should arrive to the assessment at 8:15am with student ID and Personalized Education Number (PEN) along with a pen.
