Students may begin signing up for one of their teachers for PLT on NOW. This is a student-only system – we encourage parents to have conversations with their student(s) about how they are using their Personal Learning Time.

Students that arrive at MacNeill during PLT are expected to go to a learning space (classroom) to work on what they had planned.
