- The student will have fulfilled the minimum requirements needed for graduation in June of 2017
- The student will be in attendance at the Valedictory Ceremony on Wednesday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017
- The student will have attended A.R. MacNeill Secondary for at least 2 years

Any student who wishes to have their work considered in representing the graduating class of 2017 on the cover of the Valedictory Program must submit their piece to **Mr. Banta by Monday, April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017, 3:30 p.m. Please also write a brief statement, 200 words maximum, as to why you feel your piece should be considered to be on the cover of the Valedictory program.** Submissions will be judged by a teacher selection committee.
