Reminder for Gr. 12 Students:

All 2018 grads may make an appointment with Mrs. Mayer to discuss your post-secondary plans and options. Graduating students should be in the process of submitting their post-secondary applications. BC students applying to out-of-province universities should be familiar with admission requirements, important deadlines, how to apply and submit applications before Jan 2018.

B.C. Institutions: Students may apply directly to the institution or use EducationPlannerBC: <https://apply.educationplannerbc.ca>

This service allows a student to apply to several institutions using a common form. Students will be asked to create an account using their Personal Education Number and pay an application fee for each school applied to.

Ontario Institutions: B.C. students must apply on-line through the Ontario Universities Application Website: <http://www.ouac.on.ca/ouac-105/>

It is recommended that BC students apply by mid-November . Rank your university choices. **It is also recommended that you submit official hardcopies of your grades to your choice post-secondary institutions in Ontario if required.**

Alberta Institutions: Use the on-line application service <https://applyalberta.ca/>

All Other Institutions: Varies – please check their website.

NEW! Students Transcripts Service (STS). Please note that the PSI "Choices" form is no longer available and replaced by the Students Transcripts Service (STS). Students need their PEN number to register.

The Ministry of Education has just launched the *Student Transcripts Service (STS)*, a new online application for students to view their marks, scholarships and transcripts, and send transcripts to post-secondary institutions and third parties.

To access the service, visit the Ministry of Education's *Order Transcripts and Certificates* website at www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca and follow the instructions found there.

1. **Register for a BCeID** (a BC Government account that provides you with access to B.C. Government online services)
2. **Register for the Student Transcript Service** using your BCeID
3. **Log in** to your Student Transcripts Service using your BCeID.
4. **Follow the steps in order to have transcripts sent electronically to post-secondary institutions.**

***Note:** Some Post Secondary institutions may require your grade information earlier than available through this process. Ensure you are familiar with each institution's requirements regarding grade submission. If required, order an official hardcopy transcript from the main office (\$5.00 per transcript).

Questions/concerns regarding ordering your official documents. Email:

studenttranscripts@gov.bc.ca be sure to include your name, birth date, Personal Education Number (PEN).

Document Deadlines:

Many universities & colleges require additional information such as transcripts or supplemental applications or profiles, this is called a “document deadline”. This is separate from the application deadline and varies depending on the institution.

Register to write the TOEFL/IELTS and/or the LPI if you are required to do so. Contact the Career Centre or the individual post-secondary institutions you are applying to for requirements and exemptions.

Reminders to Grade 11 Students:

If you are planning to attend a USA post-secondary institution after graduation, it is a good idea to register for and to write your SAT admission exam during your Grade 11 year! This allows enough time to have your SAT scores ready for your Fall application. See the College Board website for registration details: <http://student.collegeboard.org/>
