Students can complete this application and request a nomination from a teacher **OR** students can be nominated to complete an application. In order to apply or to be nominated, the student must have clearly expressed a passion for one of these areas of interest, as well as have a plan to pursue further studies in that area.

To be eligible for the Provincial Scholarships Program, a student:

- 1) Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident (landed immigrant) at the time of registration in the school year for which the scholarship is awarded.
- 2) Must be a B.C. resident.
- 3) Must be or have been in the school year for which the scholarship is awarded
- 4) Enrolled in a British Columbia public school (including Distributed Learning schools), or Enrolled in a Group 1, 2, or 4 British Columbia Independent School, or Enrolled in a Continuing Education Centre
- 5) Complete all graduation requirements, and be on record as having graduated, by August 31 of the scholarship awards year.
- Fulfill the graduation requirements of either the B.C. Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma) or the B.C. Adult Graduation Diploma (Adult Dogwood).
- 7) Meet the criteria determined by the student's local (school) scholarship committee, including demonstration of outstanding achievement in one of the areas listed above.

HOW TO APPLY

- a) **Submit** a MacNeill School Scholarship application (available through an online survey found at macneill.sd38.bc.ca) by **April 14, 2023** to be considered for a District Authority Scholarship.
- b) Have teacher reference support for your District Authority Application. Nominating teachers should be listed below and will provide feedback about your application.
- c) This District Authority Scholarship form must be filled in by your teacher and then dropped off by your teacher to Ms. MacDonald. All district authority scholarship nomination forms are due by April 14, 2023.
