### 11. Other Business

- Considering Inside Wall Mural in School Gym
  - School may ask for PAC Funding -\$30 000
- Principal's plan to encourage positive behaviours and diminish negative behaviours at school
  - Hard Copy of Student Agenda
    - 32 pages about school expectations and P.O.W.E.R. matrix
  - o POWER CARDS being distributed by school staff to students for POWER behaviours
  - November Blitz to do give exposure to students, build excitement with prize draws, and encourage Grade Battles between the grades
  - Possibly prize of meal for whole grade that has highest accumulation of POWER Cards
- Change of Grade Reporting for Grade 8 and 9
  - Shift to Proficiency Skills to discourage competition for grades and possible negative impact on self-esteem
- Principal Proposal for Dry Grad -give \$4000 more to Dry Grad so there is less fundraising pressure
  - Instead of \$4000, given \$8000
  - As scholarship money cannot be held over in PAC accounts for future years
  - $\circ~$  Need to be careful not to complete with Contracted Kitchen /Cafeteria Services
  - Previous Fundraising events Samosa Day, Bubble Tea Day
  - NOT X3 per month of Fundraising events in May and June
- Teacher Wish List Plans
  - Principal give Teacher Request to submit Teacher Wish List at Oct 3<sup>rd</sup> Staff Meeting
  - PAC decide on Wish Lists at Oct 18<sup>th</sup> 2023 PAC meeting
- MacNeill Merchandise Store
  - Principal considering asking new Business Teacher to be involved to create store
  - Parent suggestion Each Grade create their own designs for their own hoodies
  - Consider how PAC can help with this
