#### 6. Administration Report – Mr. John Blair

- i) Staying Connected Website, Instagram @armacneill
- ii) Student Affordability Fund for student with challenging family financial picture
  - 35 kids in the community who participate in a Lunch Program
  - \$2400 a month costs to provide from cafeteria
  - wants to offer food, clothing, athletic fees, extra course fees, costs of fieldtrips
  - looking for person in the community to have Food Back connections so can offer Breakfast Program
  - email the school if you know a family who could benefit

#### iii) Graduation Assessments 2023 -2024

- Grad Literacy Assessment was moved to January to allow more time to improve your Grad Literacy 12 grade. Can take up to 3 times. UBC has made a score of 3 or more a requirement for entry.

Jag volunteered to register to become a member of DPAC- District PAC

- 8. Treasurer Report Elihah (Co- Treasurer)
- i) Financial Report (General and Gaming Account)
  - Bank Balance for Gaming Fund \$26,991.05
  - Can remain for up to 2 years before deciding
- ii) Request to change Fiscal Year to end August 1st
  - To give time to issue cheques, have recipients cash cheques, and balance budget
  - Motion to change the Fiscal Year End to August 1st
    - Made by Jag Reehal, Approved Mary Hey
    - > Vote Unanimous decision
- iii) Request to increase the PAC donation to Dry Grad from \$4000 to \$6000 to reduce fundraising need
  - Tabled for separate Approval of Expenditures Meeting
- 9. Updates for
  - i) Incentive Representative (Kelly Kavanagh and Dana \_\_\_\_\_)
  - Possible Move of Outdoor Incentive Program
  - Due to MacNeill growing enrollment and space limits

- Evidence that new students/ parents do not get informed about Outdoor Incentive Option if their elementary school is out of their catchment
- Invite to register to participate in Incentive Outdoor Ed Focus Group on Oct 26<sup>th</sup> at 7pm
- Principal Perspective:
  - ➤ Where Cambie Secondary? smallest school with lower enrollment
  - ➤ Enrollment numbers lower than they should be can take 29 kids in each grade (Gr 8, 9, 10)
  - ➤ 28 blocks assigned to run program = 4 teachers for only 50 students
  - ➤ Considering 9/10 split classes in Incentive English and other core classes

#### ii) Dry Grad Representative

- Balance \$4322.13
- Inflatables no longer allowed due to No Indemnity Clause
- Different rooms for Grads to hang in quiet room, main gym, another room with food

### iii) School Store/Merch

- Mr. Blair having discussion with student and Staff graphic designers to develop standardized logo
- can be customized for smaller groups within the school who want to have official logo as part of club/ group/team
- able to be continued in the school and create a legacy

#### 10. Other Business

- i) Parent Concerns about MacNeill Basketball Try-Outs (Mary Yeh) that Gr 11 students have been told that they cannot try out for MacNeill Basketball Team unless they are part of MAC Hoops
  - ➤ MAC Hoops -a private organization using school gym to run a basketball program

- ➤ 2 of the 3 coaches running basketball are with community /MAC Hoops
- ➤ Principal informed that all Kids can try out do NOT need to be part of MAC Hoops

# ii) Parents concerns that younger players are taking up the positions on Grade 11 -12 Senior Basketball Team

➤ has one 9<sup>th</sup> Grader and five 10<sup>th</sup> Graders – wants opportunity for multiple students to play

#### iii) Purpose of Personal Learning times

- Mr. Blair reported that during Covid-19 they learned that some students could manage their own learning time on-line and could build independence
- Other kids needed to practice their social skills
- Options for PLT ceramics group, R & B contemporary Music, Chess Workshop, girls basketball, weight room, art, French support, GNA grade 10 assessment Prep
- Gr 8 and 9 Students are encouraged to Sign -Up for PLT and come into the school to learn how things go, and discover what they like
- Higher Grades can use their PLT to study at home or explore other passions as it is assumed that they will have greater understanding of their learning needs
- Currently the On-Line System is only being used for 317 students (out of 840) and teachers are not taking attendance
- Principal Considering combining PLT with Advisory making it 30 mins a day for 5 days a week, before lunch

#### Invite to Student Voice Forum - Mr. Blair

- Oct 23<sup>rd</sup> 2023 after school
- What are the things students want changed within the school building and in the school community
- To make it a safer and more comfortable place for students
- To tell staff what important things are happening
- Send an email to Principal to have more anonymity, or drop into private office
