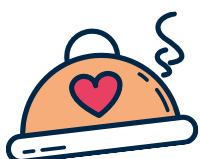

PERSONALISED LEARNING TIME (PLT)

The goal of PLT is to teach students the skills necessary to use unstructured time in a way that benefits their individual learning.

They should follow the instructions to login to their account and become familiar with the system. IDEALLY THEY SHOULD SIGN UP FOR PLT THE DAY/WEEK BEFORE. Students may begin signing up for one of their teachers for PLT on NOW. This is a student-only system – we encourage parents to have conversations with their student(s) about how they are using their Personal Learning Time.

PLT is a great time to get ahead, get caught up on work, get learning support in different ways and to pursue passions that are offered. Students that arrive at MacNeill during PLT are expected to go to a learning space (classroom) to work on what they had planned.
