The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority Leadership Program provides grade 10 and 11 secondary school students from across the Lower Mainland the opportunity to gain valuable work experience, develop their leadership skills, and make new friends.

This exciting work experience program includes two days of mandatory training on Saturday, June 14 and Sunday, June 29. **The deadline to apply is Monday, April 14.** You will be notified by e-mail if scheduled for an interview.

Through this program, leadership students:

- Gain hands-on work experience and an understanding of workplace competencies
- Build leadership skills through team building activities
- **Develop** excellent public speaking and presentation skills
- Create connections with peers and university student mentors
- Emerge with increased confidence and greater self-awareness



Leadership students are required to complete a minimum of 80 volunteer hours through training and volunteer work experience opportunities both at community events and Canada Place.

Upon completion, students are eligible to receive a \$1,000 honorarium!
