with attendance

Parents/Guardians are asked to email macneill@sd38.bc.ca or phone the school's Early Warning line directly at 604-668-6278 or you can before 9:00 AM if your child is going to be absent, late or signing out.

Please note, students are not permitted to phone in for themselves. Attendance confirmations will only be accepted by the student's parents/guardians.

When you call or email, please provide your name, whether you are the parent or guardian, and provide the following information:

- Student's first and last name, grade and student number
- Brief details about the absence or tardiness (i.e. date, reason and duration of late/absence).

If your teen needs to leave school early for an appointment, they must sign out at the office before they leave and only with parent authorization prior through email, the early warning line or signed note from a parent or we will phone home to confirm. If students arrive late to school or return after an appointment, they must sign in at the office before going to class.

For ANY attendance discrepancies regarding absences or lates please have your student or yourself speak with the teacher directly to get that adjusted.

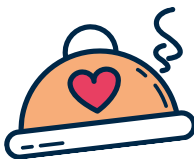
Everyone must have their school photo taken. The pictures are required for their student identification - Go Cards and for yearbook.
