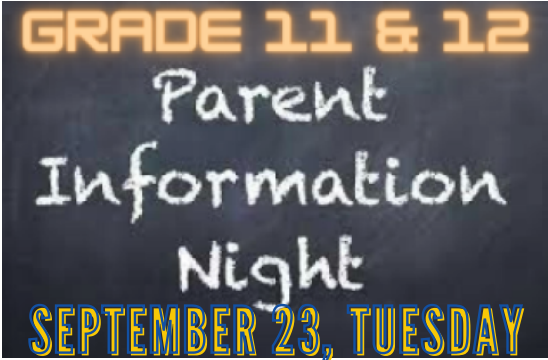
Leadership students will collect donations in Advisory class, at lunch and at Meet the Teacher night.

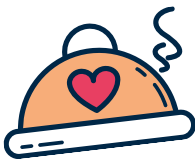
