GRADE 8s- MDI SURVEY- FEB 1 DEADLINE

The Richmond School District has partnered with the Human Early Learning Partnership (HELP) at UBC to invite students to take part in completing the Middle Years Development Instrument (MDI). The MDI is a self-report questionnaire that asks children in Grades 4 to 8 about their thoughts, feelings and experiences in school and in the community. The survey questions align with the BC Ministry of Education's K-12 curriculum which includes a focus on promoting children's personal and social competencies. The questionnaire will be administered between January 11th and March 5th, 2021. Please note that our MacNeill grade 8 students will be taking this MDI survey On Feb 8-11, 2021. Please return the form - Parent Guardian Consent letter to the main office by **Feb 1, 2021** if you do **NOT** want your child to participate.

SCHOOL FEES 2020-2021
