## RICHMOND SD38 - SEPT '21 SEMESTER SYSTEM FOR ALL SECONDARY SCHOOLS



The Richmond School District is in the process of planning for the 2021-2022 school year and we want to share some information about what the timetable structure will likely be in our secondary schools next year. As the district plans for next September, we will continue to follow the direction of the Ministry of Education and the Provincial Health Officer. After considering input from our stakeholder representatives, the district has made the decision to have all our secondary schools operate on a semester system for the 2021-2022 school year. The primary rationale for this decision is that the semester system will provide the greatest degree of flexibility for schools to transition to or from the quarter system if the Provincial Health Office mandates requirements similar to this school year. Thank you for your understanding during these exceptional times. You can anticipate receiving additional details from the principal of your child's school in the months ahead.
